

LETTER OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN:

THE YUKON LAW FOUNDATION
(the Foundation)

AND:

(the Student)

1. Background

- 1.1 The Foundation is established pursuant to the *Legal Profession Act*. Among its objectives is:
 - contributing to the legal education and knowledge of members of the profession and the people of the Yukon and providing programs and facilities therefor.
- 1.2 Further to that objective, the Foundation from time to time provides financial assistance to deserving students pursuing a program of law or law-related studies who intend to return to the Yukon at some time and use those law-related studies in the Yukon.
- 1.3 The Student is enrolled in a program of law or law-related studies for the 20 /20 academic year and has applied to the Foundation for financial assistance.
- 1.4 The Student has committed to return to the Yukon after completing his/her law or law-related studies.
- 1.5 The Foundation has agreed, based upon the Student's commitment to return to the Yukon, to provide funds to assist the Student in pursuing those law or law-related studies.

2. Understanding

The Foundation and the Student agree as follows:

- 2.1 Having received proof of the Student's enrollment in a program of law or law or law-related studies for the 2 - 2 academic year, the Foundation will pay to the Student the amount of \$ (the Scholarship).
- 2.2 The Student agrees that it is her/his intention, following the completion of his/her law or law-related studies which studies include any time spent as an articulated student, to return to the Yukon and use his/her legal or law-related education in some capacity for a period of at least two years.
- 2.3 The Student recognizes the Foundation's intent in granting the scholarships and further recognizes that the Law Foundation has limited funds from which to grant such scholarships.
- 2.4 Accordingly, if the Student chooses not to return to the Yukon, he/she undertakes to repay the Scholarship amount to the Yukon Law Foundation, thereby allowing that amount to be distributed to another deserving student.
- 2.5 If the Student does return to the Yukon but is unable to remain in the Yukon or to use his/her law-related education for the full two year period, he/she undertakes to contact the Foundation in order to confirm the portion of the Scholarship amount to be repaid to the Foundation and the terms upon which repayment should occur.
